

Changes to Cash Cup and MVP Shootout Effective Spring 2024

Effective Spring Session 2024 we will be returning to an annual Tournament for both the Cash Cup and the MVP Shootout Tournaments. These annual tournaments will take place in the Spring Session and will feature larger payouts than the individual session tournaments we run currently.

Qualifying Structure for Cash Cup

Qualifying for the Cash Cup will return to the way it used to be. Your team will need to finish in the top 50% of your division in 2 of the 3 sessions. The qualifying period will begin in Spring and run through Summer and Fall Sessions.

Qualifying Structure for the MVP Shootout

To qualify for the MVP Shootout, you will need to finish in the top 12 of your skill level group, league wide, in any of the 3 sessions beginning with the Spring and running through the Summer and Fall. The skill level groups for 8-Ball will be 2/3, 4/5 and 6/7. The skill level group for 9-Ball will be 1-3, 4-6, 7-9. The top 12 (plus ties) in each session will qualify for the MVP Shootout in the Spring Session.

This change will not affect the Cash Cup or MVP Shootout set to take place this current Spring Session. They will still run exactly as they have for the past 3 years.
